Some of the skills you will be learning could include:

- Webbing
- Springing
- Traditional Stuffing and Stitching
- Modern materials and their uses
- Corner cuts and folds
- Basic wood revival techniques

Chosen Project:

Your chosen piece to work on must be suitable and pre-approved by Wells and White Bespoke Upholstery.

Important:

Please send through picture and dimensions of your project for us to confirm suitable before the project starts. The piece must fit on one of our 90 by 90cm tables.

Any sewing for traditional classes will need to be undertaken privately or by prearrangement with Wells and White Bespoke Upholstery.

Storage:

As you can imagine space is limited therefore we require you to take your project home with you between classes unless special arrangements have been agreed prior to the course starting.

Tools Required:

Traditional tools you will need for the course are listed below. You may have some or all listed, if so please bring them along. If not, there are three options:

1. Purchase any tools required. Please refer to our tools pricelist in the workshop
2. Purchase a starter kit including most of the tools you will require.
3. Use of one of our starter kits during your class time in the workshop, any missing items at the end of the day would be charged as per our tool's pricelist.

Tools Starter Kit:

- Web stretcher
- Magnetic tack hammer
- Tack lifter
- Staple lifter

- Regulator
- Pincers

Items required for the course:

- Fabric tape measure
- Upholstery pins
- Scissors

Additional Items that may be required for the course that you may wish to bring along if necessary:

- Sewing needles (curved mattress needle)

NB We are unable to loan out pins, needles or skewers, due to their small nature and ability to lose, these would need to be purchased.

Top Fabrics:

Please feel free to browse our fabrics and trim samples or pick our brains on styles you may be after and we can help point you in the right direction. We have trade access to most fabric houses and are happy for you to purchase fabrics through ourselves.

Materials:

There will be a folder for students to record all the materials used on their project. Students are responsible for keeping this record accurate and up to date. Students will be invoiced at the end of the term.
